

Milwaukee man pays \$8 million for Rembrandt

MILWAUKEE (AP) — Milwaukee businessman and art collector Alfred Bader paid nearly \$8 million for a portrait by Rembrandt.

Bader, a multimillionaire who helped found Aldrich Chemical Co., bought Rembrandt's Portrait of Johannes Uytenbogaert Wednesday at Sotheby's sale of old master paintings in London.

The piece, a 1633 portrait of a religious leader from Holland, represents one of more than 50 portraits Rembrandt painted while in Amsterdam.

Sotheby's had estimated the piece would go for \$5 million.
