McTavish said. "They are on his doorstep all the time."

Bader, who lives in the United States, made it big in research chemicals and pharmaceuticals.

His gifts to Queen's are becoming legendary. Besides the English castle, he has already:

- contributed more than 120 paintings
- set up a teaching position in northern 17th century art

- given \$80,000 to conserve art pieces

- given \$2 million (US) to be used toward a new art gallery or other project.

- promised a \$1 million fellowship fund if the university sets up a PhD program in art history.

Expansion plans call for the Etherington home to be preserved along with the centre's 1975 wing. The 1960 wing would be replaced with a

new 52,000-square-foot building.

Queen's needs local municipalities to sponsor the university's bid for federal and provincial job-creation funds.

But local taxpayers are not being asked for any money.

Queen's expects to contribute \$6 million to cover the local share of funding.
