

# United Nations and Peace Will Be Hutton Topic

Graham Hutton, representative of the British information services in the United States, will address the February meeting of the Milwaukee County League of Women Voters at 2 p. m. Friday at the Republican hotel. "The United Nations Build for Peace" will be his subject. He will be introduced by Mrs. Douglass Van Dyke, foreign policy chairman.

The league will also hear a report by Mrs. W. A. Hambley, co-chairman of economic welfare, on the work of the Milwaukee council on housing, of which, as league representative, she is chairman. Mrs. Vernon Waters, education chairman, will report on the league's request for social hygiene lectures in the public schools, and Mrs. Wendell Phelps, state chairman of foreign policy, will discuss the new foreign policy broadside, "Lend-Lease; War Debts Again?"
